A game for two players

You will need:

A copy of the grid

A way of generating numbers between 1 and 12 (eg a twelve sided dice, a shuffled pack of playing cards or a spinner) Two colours of pen (one for each player)

How to play (assuming you use a dice):

Player one rolls the dice He then multiplies the answer on the dice by 6 Player one now marks a vertical or horizontal line adjacent to the correct answer of his choice on the grid

Player two takes a turn

Once a square has been surrounded on all four sides by a single coloured pen, it can be completely coloured in, and counts as one point for that player.

The winner is the player with the most coloured squares at the end of the game.
